1. Organization Overview

The Korea Reserve & Retired Officers' Association (KOROA) is a nonprofit incorporated association established to bring together former and retired officers of the Republic of Korea Army, Navy, Air Force, and Marine Corps, regardless of service branch or commissioning background. KOROA promotes unity among former officers, carries forward the values of military leadership and devoted service to the nation, and contributes to national security awareness and the public good. KOROA received authorization for incorporation on January 31, 2024, with the Ministry of National Defense of the Republic of Korea as its supervising ministry. The Canada Chapter is an officially recognized overseas chapter of KOROA.

2. Mission

KOROA Canada promotes fellowship and cooperation among former Republic of Korea military officers residing in Canada and applies the values of honor, responsibility, dedication, and service to the broader community. The Chapter seeks to strengthen friendship and cooperation between the Republic of Korea and Canada and to contribute positively to the Korean-Canadian community. It places particular importance on honoring Canadian veterans who served during the Korean War and on passing the legacy of their sacrifice and service to future generations.
